- On January 22, 2019, FRANKLIN was released from detention by a United States
 District Judge.
- 4. On January 23, 2019, FRANKLIN completed her testimony before a grand jury investigating violations of U.S. criminal law, thereby satisfying her obligations in this material-witness matter, which is now closed.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Government's Motion to Partially Unseal and its proposed order be placed under seal until further order of this Court, but this Order shall be made available to the public.
